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I. Introduction

For those using the Adobe Programs to export Tier 1 or Tier 2 deliverables, presets are provided for the Adobe programs that include the correct export settings. If the presets are not installed on your machine, you can download and install them following the instructions in this document.

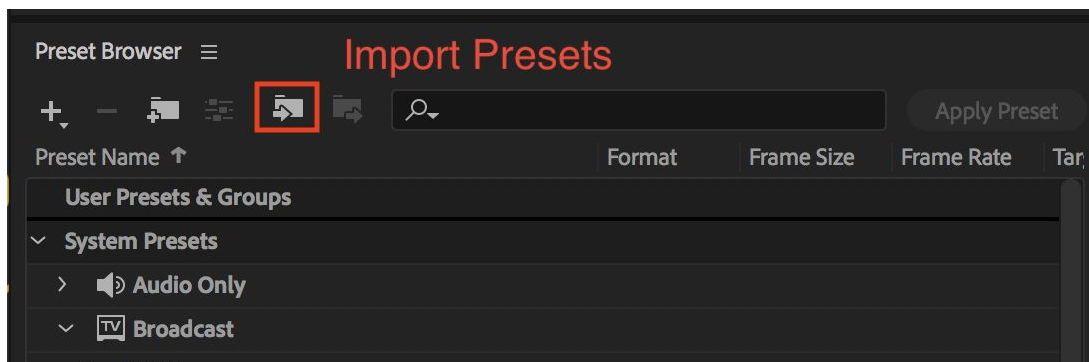
II. Downloading Adobe Presets

III. Importing Adobe Presets

A. Adobe Media Encoder

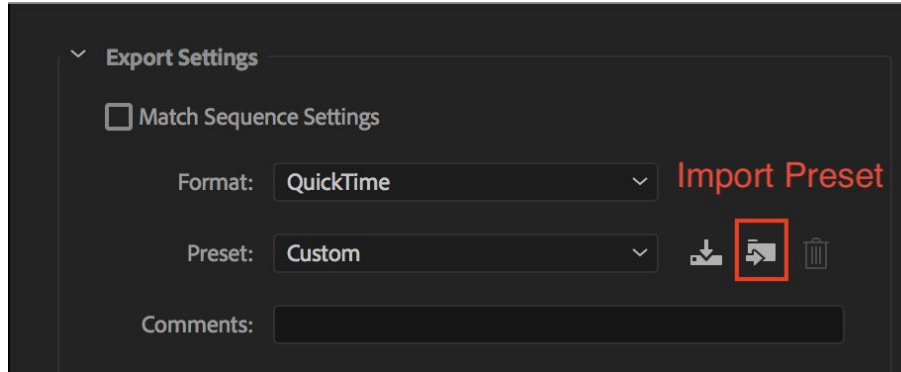
1. Open Media Encoder
2. In the Preset Browser tab, click the **IMPORT PRESETS** button.



3. Navigate to your downloaded presets to import. The presets will appear in the presets browser window under **User Presets & Groups**.

B. Adobe Premiere

1. Open Premiere
2. Navigate to the Export page under **File > Export**
3. Under the export settings, click on the **IMPORT PRESET** button.



4. Navigate to your downloaded presets to import. The presets will appear in the **Preset** dropdown and will change based upon which format you have chosen in the **Format** dropdown. If your preset called “My Preset” is set for an H.264 export format, it will only appear in the **Preset** dropdown list if H.264 is selected in the **Format** dropdown.
